certain Oil Marketing Companies, namely, Indian Oil Corporation Limited, Hindustan Petroleum Corporation Limited and Bharat Petroleum Corporation Limited and has referred the matter to Director General, CCI for investigation.

(c) & (d) The CCI has given time upto 2^{nd} October, 2013 to DG, CCI to submit the investigation report.
