(a) to (d):-The Companies Act, 2013 has been assented by the President of India on 29.08.2013 and published in the Official Gazette on 30.08.2013 which empowers the Central Government to bring into force various sections from such date(s) as may be notified. Accordingly, 98 Sections of the Companies Act, 2013 have been notified on 12.09.2013. The rest of the provisions including section 455 of the Companies Act, 2013 dealing with dormant company is yet to be notified as it prescribe Rules also to be notified while notifying the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013. Thus extensive

Consultations with stakeholders, public at large and other Regulators are being carried out.
