


Overview

The Digital Signature Certificates (DSC) which are generated in the MCA21 application needs to be digitally validated. This document explains the steps to validate a DSC.

Validating a Digital Signature Certificates

1. Download the Certificate corresponding to approved SRN from the MCA21 application.
2. Open the certificate and check whether the signature is validated or not. If DSC marked as “?” then we need to validate the digital signature.

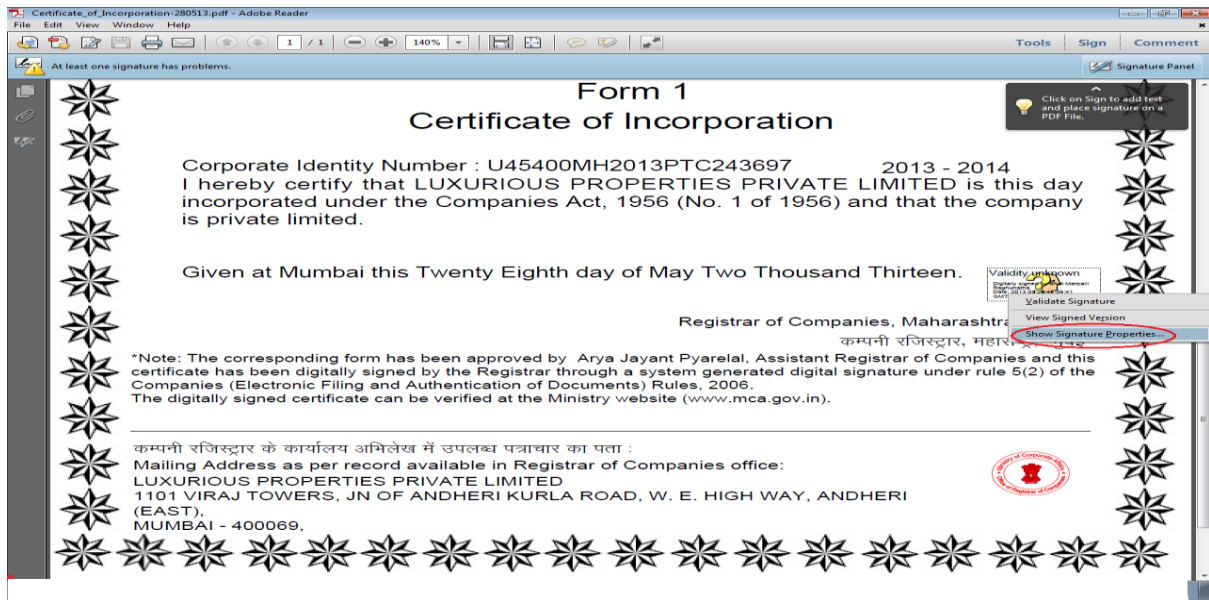

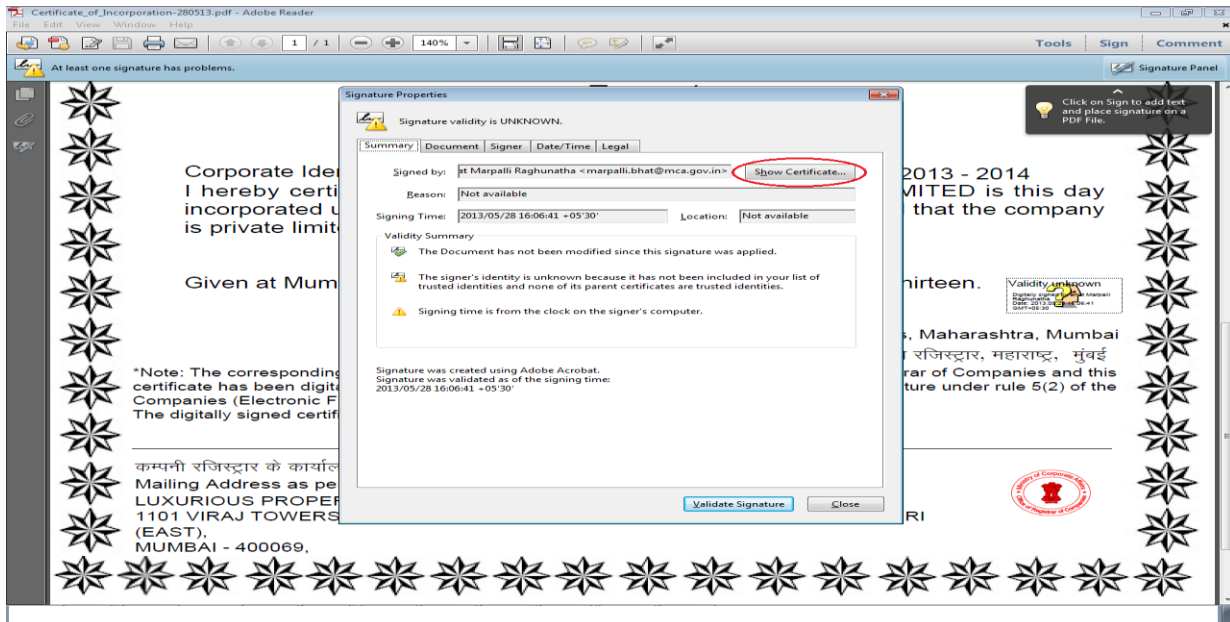

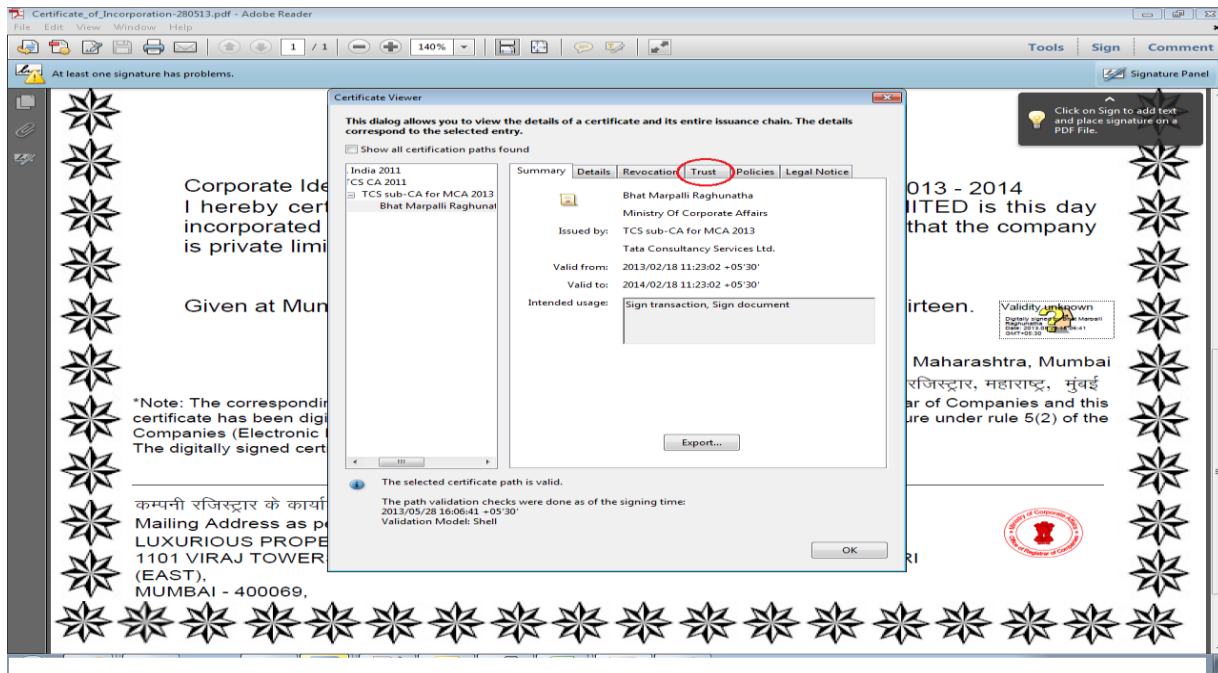
3. Right click on the signature and select the **Show Signature Properties** command from the right-click menu.



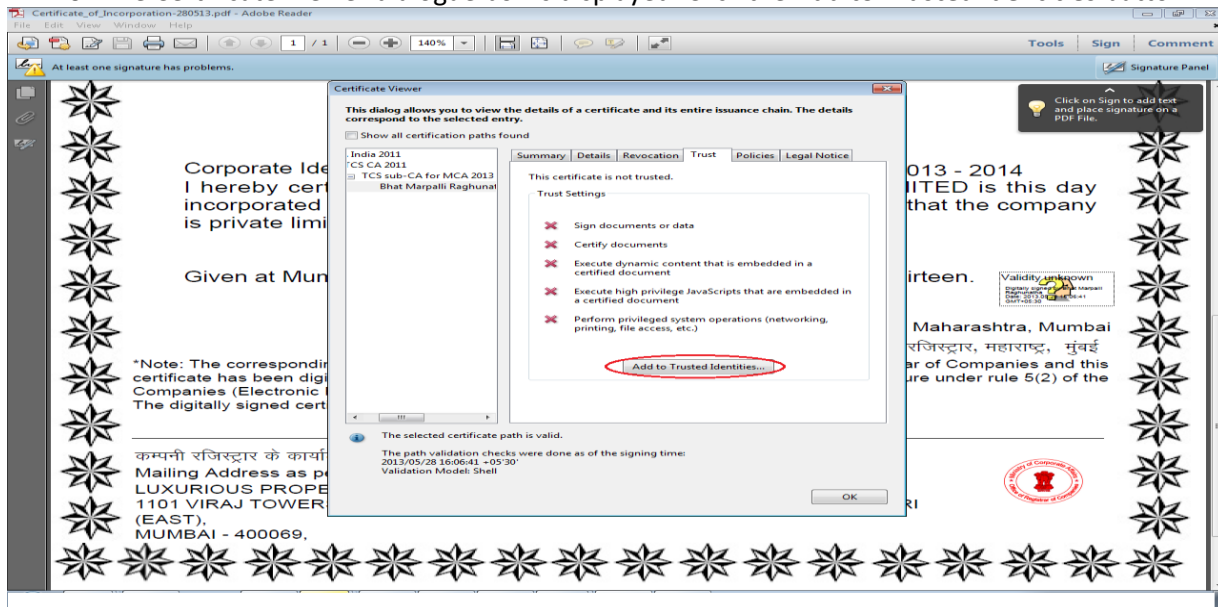
4. The Signature properties dialogue box is displayed. The Summary tab is selected by default. Click the **Show Certificate** button.



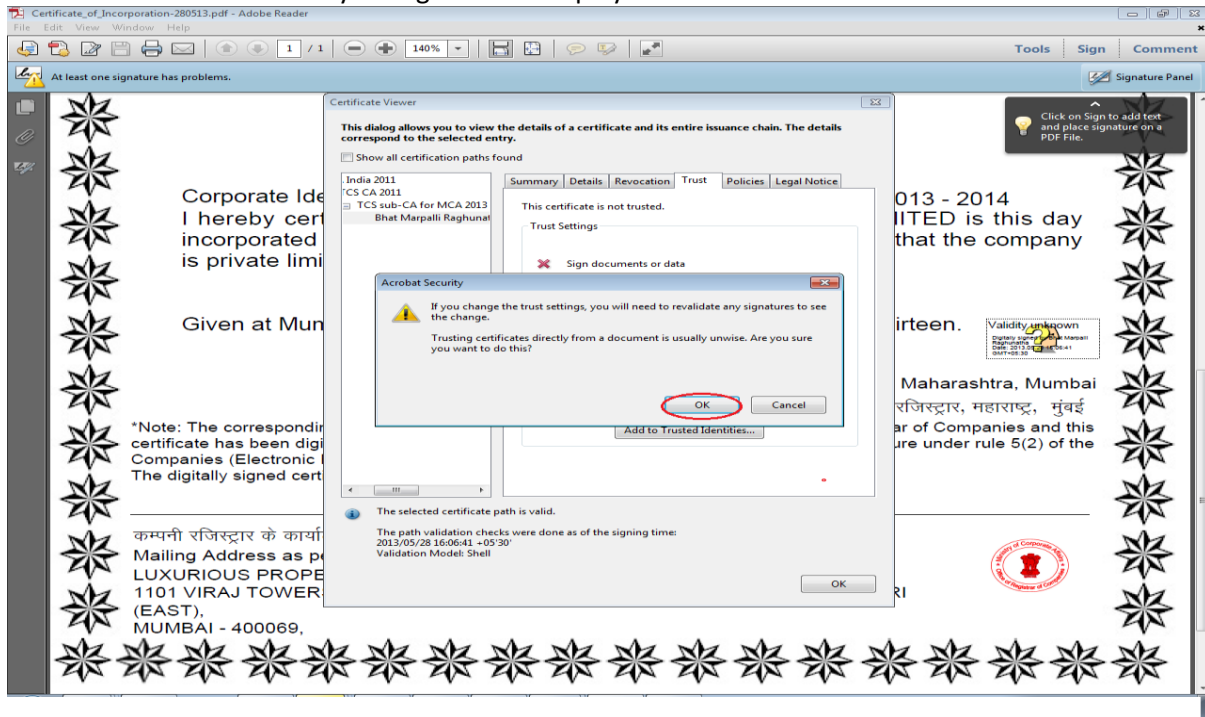
5. The Certificate Viewer dialogue box is displayed. The Summary tab is selected by default. Click the **Trust** tab.



6. The Certificate Viewer dialogue box is displayed. Click the **Add to Trusted Identities** button.



7. The Acrobat Security dialogue box is displayed. Click **OK** to continue.



8. The Import Contact Settings dialogue box is displayed. Select the following options:

- **Certified Documents**
 - **Dynamic Content**
 - **Embedded high privilege JavaScript**
 - **Privilege system operations (networking, printing, file access etc.)**

9. Click **OK** to close the Import Contact Settings dialogue box.
