
OFFICE ORDER

The continuation of ad-hoc appointment of the above mentioned officials is subject to the following terms and conditions stipulated in OM No 4/2/2006-CS.II(B) (Vol II) dated 4th January 2017 and OM No. 11/1/2015-CS.II (B) dated 12th February 2015 issued by DoPT and all other conditions prescribed by the DoPT for ad hoc appointment from time to time:

- i. Continuance of ad-hoc appointment shall not confer on the appointees any right to continue in the Assistant Section Officer Grade indefinitely or for inclusion in the Select List of ASOs of CSS or to claim seniority in Assistant Section Officer Grade of CSS.
- ii. Ad-hoc appointments may be terminated at any point of time without giving any reason therefore.
- iii. The ad-hoc appointee would attend and qualify the mandatory training as and when nominated by CS.I (Training) Section of DoPT, (if not already done), failing which they shall have no claim for inclusion in the regular select list of Assistant Section Officer.
