- (a) whether any steps have been taken by the Competition Commission of India (CCI) for anti-competitive agreements under the Competition Act, 2002; and
- (b) if so, the steps taken during the last three years, State-wise?

(a) & (b) During the last three years, the Competition Commission of India (CCI) has passed cease and desist orders in 14 cases and cease and desist orders along with a penalty of Rs.7354.118 crore in another 14 cases of anti-competitive agreements.
