Will the Minister of CORPORATE AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of fake finance companies being run in the country, State-wise;
- (b) the quantum of loss suffered by consumers thereon;
- (c) whether any enquiry was conducted by the Government during the last three years in this regard; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?
