1438. SHRI GOPAL SHETTY:

Will the Minister of CORPORATE AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the rising number of cases relating to this ministry in various courts is a matter of serious concern;
- (b) if so, the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether the Government has constituted or proposed to constitute any group of experts for evolving any system to reduce the number of pending cases; and
- (d) if so, the details in this regard?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF CORPORATE AFFAIRS (SHRI ARUN JAITLEY)

- (a) & (b): The Ministry has not received such concerns. This Ministry administers Companies Act, 1956/ 2013 which includes filing of prosecution cases against the defaulting companies and their directors/ officers in default, which are pending in various courts in the country.
