(a) to (e): The advocacy programmes for CSR undertaken by the Indian Institute of Corporate Affairs (IICA), a body established under the Ministry of Corporate Affairs, brought out the need for having trained CSR professionals who can help corporates to implement their CSR projects. IICA has accordingly launched a programme– 'IICA Certificate Programme (ICP) in CSR' as a capacity building programme for CSR professionals. It is a nine months programme, delivered primarily through an online Learning Management System (LMS). The first batch of the programme was recently launched on 13th October 2014.
